### Coronavirus Update

The Bishops' Conference of England and Wales, having consulted the Ordinaries of the Dioceses, has agreed that the cessation of public liturgies should begin from Friday evening 20th March 2020. Because of the situation the Church finds herself in, the obligation for the faithful to attend Holy Mass on a Sunday or Holy day of Obligation is removed, until further notice.

Therefore, public Masses **will not be said** in the church. Fr Paul will be celebrating Masses privately, in a closed church, for any intentions he receives, including those that have already been requested. Unfortunately, you will not be able to be physically present in the church for any Mass, but Fr Paul invites you to join him in Spiritual Communion by using the prayers available in the porch.

**The church will be opened for prayer before the Blessed Sacrament on the following days:-**

**Sunday 9.30am to 10.30am**

**Tuesday 6.30pm to 7.30pm**

**Thursday 9.15am – 10.15am**

**Confessions** will also be available at these times or other times on request.

**Social distancing in church:** Please come in during these hours to light a candle, to pray in the church and to be in the presence of Our Lord Jesus who dwells among us.

When you are in the church during opening hours, please observe the government's guidelines on personal hygiene, hand-washing, and social distancing: you must be at least 6 feet (2 metres) apart from the next person, and regrettably there can be no communal or group prayers in the church.

***Please make use of the hand sanitiser on entrance and exit of the church and keep the recommended distance between you and the next person!***

**Lent Stations of the Cross** – are cancelled with immediate effect.

**Sacramental Programs** – Baptism, First Holy Communion, Confirmation and Weddings are suspended.

**The Sacrament of the Sick** will be administered in emergency situations on request. We will be unable to continue to bring Holy Communion to the housebound except in emergencies. If someone you know becomes seriously ill, please still call Fr Paul.

**Weekly newsletter** will be available with up to date information on a Thursday. Please download it from the parish website or a few paper copies will be available for collection from the church porch but these **must be taken away with you.**

**Mass Offerings** – these can be placed in an envelope and posted through the Presbytery door or handed into the parish office.

**The Parish Office** will be open on Tuesday and Thursday 10am to 2pm. Telephone enquiries should be made during those times.

**The Parish Hall** is not available for use until further notice.
