## GENERAL ELECTION QUESTIONS FROM CAFOD/SVP

The J&P group would like to invite parishioners to join a group that hopes to put the Catholic voice across in the upcoming General Election. In order to arrive at the polling station as well informed as possible, it's important for each of us to know what our prospective MP's views are on the issues that matter. We can reach the candidates in a variety of ways by writing letters, video meetings, attending hustings and questioning them when they knock on our doors .... we decide what to do. In particular, we hope to find out what the candidates think about the big issues of our time such as climate control, cost of living crisis, debt cancellation, migration and asylum, global hunger, business and human rights, aid and international development and regional inequalities. Our group would form part of a countrywide initiative called 'A Year of Encounter' organised by CAFOD and the SVP. They have identified these eight key guestions and how to present them in an easy way to the candidates. You will find details of all of them on the parish website.
